Writing

This half term, year 5 will be writing in a range of genres including formal letters, scripts and poetry. These will all be based on the book of Matilda by Roald Dahl.

Year 6 will be covering a wider range of genres based on a number of different stimuli as we prepare for final writing assessments. These include setting descriptions, writing to persuade, character descriptions and poetry.

Reading

In our reading sessions, children will revisit skills in order to consolidate their reading from throughout the year.

Key areas to be covered include:

- choice of language
- text scanning to find information
- development of themes in novels

Maths

Year 6 will be completing consolidation projects which provide an opportunity to revisit many of the skills and curriculum content covered both in Year 6 and also the rest of Key Stage 2. These projects include Futures and White Rose Bakery projects

Year 5 will be completing the final blocks of the year: position and direction, statistics, converting units and volume

Texts



RE

This term our RE topic is called 'Dialogue and Encounter' - our other faiths topic.

Year 5 will be studying Judaism. They will learn the history of the Jewish faith, analyse Hebrew scripture, its links to Christian faith and about Rosh Hashanah.

Year 6 will learn about Hinduism including: Karma and Dharma, the Hindu creation story and hopefully a trito a Hindu temple.

Science

In science we will be learning about Electricity.

They will explore series circuits and how to construct, draw and create variations within them. They will plan, conduct and evaluate a practical investigation on voltage.

They will also complete a short 2 week unit on fossils.

Computing

Our computing strand this term is 'Data and Information'.

Year 5 will be learning about the databases and year 6 will study spreadsheets. They will learn the purposes for them, how to use them and create their own for a given brief.

Geography

In Geography, both year 5 and 6 will consider the question "Why does population change?".

They will work to understand the change and distribution of the global population, understand birth and death rates, know factors influencing migration and consider the impact of climate change of the changing global population.

Art

This half term, we are studying Art. Children will use clay to create sculptures along the theme of "Making Memories".

They will explore the concept of self, practice sculptural techniques, develop ideas to plan a sculpture and learn how to problem solve refine their artwork to achieve a chosen outcome.

PSHE

This term, our PSHE topic is 'Growing Up'.

This topic explores the changes that the human body experience through puberty and the nature of growing up.

Please see the letter sent home with children and on ParentHub for more details of this unit of work.

In Pentecost 2, we will be working towards composing and performing a leaving song.

We will listen to and describe music, learn how to write lyrics, organise lyrics into a song structure, compose melodies against a backing track and perform the song to others. Year 5/6

PE

All pupils will be practicing athletics this term in PE.

Across the phase, pupils will be learning and practicing running a range of distances, jumping techniques and preparing for Sports Day.

Year 6 will develop this further by learning about the effects of different exercise on the body.

Forest Schools

This half term, pupils will continue to develop their skills with knots, summer rules, nature art and den building, as well as developing their skills when using a range of tools.

Please ensure that children have brought a pair of wellies (with socks) to keep at school for Forest Schools. Please also remember the children will continue to need their arms and legs covered for each session.

French

In French, we will begin a new topic of Clothes!

Pupils will learn vocabulary of items of clothing and learn how to add colour adjectives in accordance to grammatical rules. They will also learn how to express an opinion of what they like and dislike and describe an outfit using adjectives correctly.
