Writing

In our Year 1 and Year 2 writing, we will be writing instructions and a diary entry. Year 1 writing skills: Joining words using conjunctions. using capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks, Orally composing and using adjectives. Year 2 writing skills: Exclamation sentences, apostrophes for omission and possession. Planning sentences. Subordinating and coordinating conjunctions and the progressive form of the verb.

Year 1/2

Reading

This half term we are reading my bean diary and the tall tale of the giants causeway alongside our regular weekly phonics books. Year 2 reading- check the text makes sense to them and answer questions to check for understanding of a range of texts. Year 1 comprehension: Composing a sentence orally before writing it and sequencing sentences.

Maths

Year 1- Begin to have a deeper understanding of multiplication and division using arrays, equal groups and repeated addition of the 2, 5, and 10s. Be able to find and recognise ½ ¼ of a shape and number.

Year ¹/₂- Begin to have a deeper understanding of money. Recognising money, counting money in pounds and pence and calculating money. Be able to find a half, a third, a whole and a quarter of a shape and numbers.

Year 2- Begin to have a deeper understanding of fractions by finding a half, a quarter, three quarter and counting in fractions.

RE

Know the story of Pentecost.

Know that Jesus promised a special friend and he sent us the Holy Spirit to guide us.

Know the symbols of the Holy Spirit.

Know that the church is a special place where we meet our friends, sing and say prayers.

Science

Year 1: Planting and Plants (Biology) Where we will be observing change of different flowering plants. Identifying the different parts of plants and trees. Identifying wild and garden flowers and associating them with plants in our local area. Finally, understanding and identifying the difference of deciduous and evergreen trees.

Year 2: Plants, bulbs and seeds (3 weeks) We are going t to be idenitfying and comparing bulbs and seeds for different plants. To explore and answer the question what do plants need to grow and to plan a plant investigation. Growing up (2weeks) To recognise parent and offspring and to explain the life cycle of

Music

In music we will be focusing on the key vocabulary timbre and rhythmic patterns.We are also going to practise experiencing different roles when perfoming in

a group performance.

PSHE

Keeping Safe We will be focusing on what a good or bad secret is, describing what private parts are (Pantosaurus) and to know God created our bodies and we need to take care of them.

Oracy

Throughout our lessons we are going to be implementing our oracy framework which focuses on the children's physical, linguistic, cognitive, social and emotional development.

History/Geography

In History (3 weeks) We will be exploring the Wright Brothers.

In Geography (2 weeks) We are going to be exploring Northern Irelands location and the physical and human features of the country.

Art

In Art this half term we will be focusing on different mechanisms. We are going to be making a very exciting moving monster. We will be creating our own design after looking at objects and how they move.

PENTECOST 1

Year 1 and 2 will both be focusing on athletics by exploring how to run at different speeds, developing balance, changing directions quickly, hopping/jumping and various throwing techniques.

PE

They will also be practicing the fundamentals for net and wall games within first grade sports .

Computing

Year 1: Creating media-Digital writing. We are going to be practically exploring the computer to write, add and remove text, change the font and compare how typing on a computing is different/similar to writing on paper.

Year 2: Creating media- Digital writing. We are going to be exploring how music can make you feel by experimenting with sound using a computer and create musical patterns and musical for a purpose using our technology skills.

Forest School

Forest Schools is a child-centred learning process, providing learner inspired, hands-on experiences in the natural environment. The children will be given the opportunity to take part in a 1 hour session each week. The session will be child initiated that will run alongside an activity to help develop social and emotional skills, support wellbeing, while also exploring nature.

This term the children will be experiencing tool talk, how to safely handle tools, to use a peeler and bow saw and to work with a partner to successfully drill and cut wood.
