# PENTECOST

History & Geography

### For 3 weeks

For 3 weeks in Geography we will be looking at the four seasons, the weather today and around the UK

For the remaining 3 weeks, in History we will be looking at the significance of the moon landing, Neil Armstrong and then comparing two explorers (Neil Armstrong and Ibn Battuta).

### Computing

Year 1 Programming

We are going to: create an algorithm to program a robot; think about what impact did it have when the algorithm did not go to plan; and select an algorithm and break it into chunks.

### Year 2 Programming

We are going to: create an algorithm for a program with a given design; give an overview of how precise instructions move a sprite and predict the outcomes and pose improvements by debugging the program.

### PSHE

In PSHE we are focusing on Keeping Safe.

We are going to be thinking about the importance of knowing what a good secret and bad secret is. We will also be describing why private parts are private and identifying the feelings linked to being unsafe.

### Art

In Art this half term we are going to create 3D Clay Houses.

We will be learning and applying techniques to shape clay using tools and our hands. We will plan features of a 3D model and then create one from a drawn design.

# PENTECOST

### Forest Scho<mark>ol</mark>

Forest Schools is a child-centred learning process, providing learner inspired, hands-on experiences in the natural environment. The children will be given the opportunity to take part in a 1 hour session each week. The session will be child initiated that will run alongside an activity to help develop social and emotional skills, support wellbeing, while also exploring nature.

#### Shelter Building

Year 1 This half term the children will be safely holding tools and listen/ understand tool talk. We will also be using a peeler and a bow

saw to cut and discuss a 1 - 2 - 1 Year 2 This half term will be using tools safely and working with a <u>partner to cut, drill and peel</u> wood.

### PE

Year 1 and Year 2 will both be focusing on Dance and Sending and receiving.

In Sending and receiving, we will be thinking about how we can catch and throw and kick a ball. Also how we can roll a ball to hit a target.

In Dance, we will be copy, remember and repeating actions, using dance to move in time and moving body parts in isolation and together. We will also look at moving in unison and thinking about levels.
