### Reading

Children will be making predictions based on parts of the text theyhave read and giving evidence for their predictions.

They will also be making comparisons within and across non-fiction texts.

#### Maths

To continue, both year groups will be completing White Rose blocks on:

Y5 - Decimals, negative numbers, converting measurements and volume

Y6 - A variety of topic based projects incorporating knowledge and skills from the past year.

#### RE

This term our RE topic is called 'Dialogue and Encounter'

Children will learn how our own faith interlinks with other faiths around the world and how we are called to live in tolerance with those who have different beliefs.

We will also have an Other Faiths week focusing on Islam

#### Science

In science we will be learning about:

- reversible and irreversible changes
  including filtering, sieving and evaporation
- plastic pollution and its impact on our planet. Children will conduct and investigation and interpret the data they find to draw conclusions on this.

#### Computing

Our computing strand this term is 'Programming'.

Year 5 will be learning about creating algorithms to create online quizzes Year 6 will learn about creating programs that use sensing inputs, using a Micro:Bit to create a pedometer.

ART

#### History and Geography

Our history topic this term is WW2 and its impact on the people of Britain at the time. Pupil will explore the evacuation, roles of women and the Battle of Britain.

In Geography, they will complete a mapping unit about North America. Then they will love onto a topic of where our energy is sources how it is distributed and consider the impact of solar panels.

PSHE

We will continue with our topic in PSHE is Me, My Body and My Health.
