Parent Governor Position

Have you ever thought about becoming a Parent Governor at your child's school?

Here at English Martyrs', we have provision for one additional parent governor, and there will be one vacancy from January 2026. This is a great opportunity to get involved in a fulfilling, interesting and rewarding role, where you can make a real difference in the education and life chances of the young people in our care. The Local Governing Body (LGB) works in partnership with and in support of the school, endeavouring to set a high standard of expectation and ambition which drives forward the work of the staff and helps to create a bright future for our students.

No specific qualifications are needed; the most important thing is to have a keen interest in the school and to be prepared to play an active part in the LGB's work. However, we would particularly welcome nominations from parents with skills/interest in: Wellbeing; Safeguarding; any Curriculum subjects. Availability to visit the school occasionally during the day would be a real bonus, increasing Governor contact and visibility, but I realise that this may not be an option in all cases. Training is available for all governors, and our LGB has an expectation that those new to school governance attend induction training, as well as other available training as applicable.

Safeguarding at English Martyrs'

All staff at English Martyrs' have compulsory yearly training regarding the updated document from the Department for Education, Keeping Children Safe in Education. Just a gentle reminder that it is our statutory duty to raise any concerns we have that children or adults bring to our attention. We recognise that this is not always a comfortable conversation but one that must be had in order for us to complete our record keeping and update conversations with any agency referrals that have been made.
