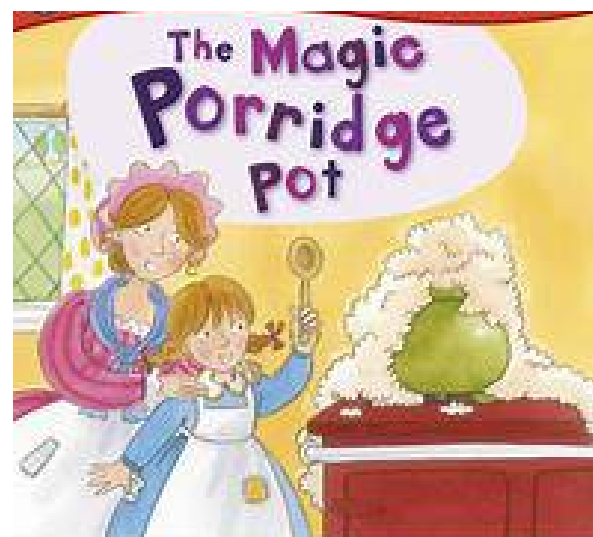

What can you see at the coast?

Label the bodies of water that surround the UK.
Describe some key human physical features of coast in the UK
Summarise features of coasts; labelling features on a photograph.
Summarise how people use coasts.
Investigate using multiple sources of evidence including atlases maps and photos to help us to understand a coastal location.
